Google Cloud PHP Autoloader is a Magento extension for autoloading Google Cloud PHP libraries and dependencies. It is intended to be used with Magento 1.x only, as Magento 2 provides native support for Composer.

Enable Google Cloud PHP Autoloader: Disabled by default. Google Cloud PHP classes will not be autoloaded while the extension is disabled.

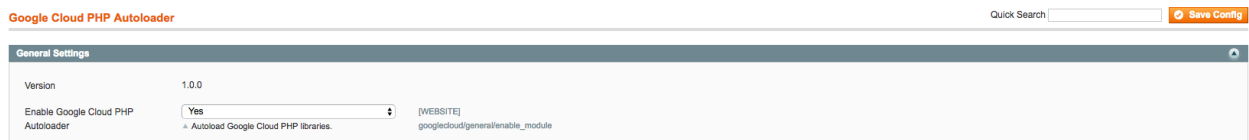


Figure 1: General Settings
